Using Gift Aid means that for every £1 you give, we can boost your donation by 25p

Example: If you give a gift of £100 we can claim back an additional £25. This makes your donation actually worth £125, at no extra cost or effort to you.

Gift Aid Declaration Form

3. You must be a UK taxpayer and understand that if you pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your donations in the tax year it is your responsibility to pay any difference.
4. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we reclaim, you must cancel your declaration.
5. If you pay Income Tax at the higher rate or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HMRC to adjust your tax code.
6. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
